Dear Parents/Guardians:

This year the fall sports sign-up registration form will once again be located online in the **Genesis Parent Portal** under the “**Forms**” tab on July 1, 2018. You must complete an online sign-up form for each child in your family who is signing up for a fall sport and acknowledge your receipt of the concussion and sudden cardiac fact sheets.

In order for your child to participate in a fall sport at EHMS, you and/or your physician must complete three forms required by the State of New Jersey: a Health History Form, a Physical Exam Form and a Sports Permission/Emergency Information Form. All of these forms are located in the Hoppock health office or can be downloaded online via the sign-up registration form and/or the school website. **The forms must be completed by August 15, 2018** in order to provide the school with adequate time to obtain final medical approval from the school doctor prior to the start of fall sports’ tryouts/practices.

Health History - MUST BE COMPLETED ONCE PER CALENDAR YEAR by you and reviewed by your health practitioner (physician, physician assistant or nurse practitioner). *If the health questionnaire was completed more than 90 days prior to the first day of practice, a health history update needs to be completed for each season*

Physician Evaluation must be completed by your health practitioner within 365 days of the first practice session (once per calendar year - please provide original copy).

Sports Permission – At sign up emergency information for coaches must be completed. This form is required for each sports season.

Only those students with all medical documentation completed and approved by the school medical examiner at the start of the school year will be allowed to participate in any sports practices or competition.

Dear 5th Grade Parents/Guardians:


Your child will be entering Ethel Hoppock Middle School in August 2018 and we are very excited to welcome him/her. However, this is to inform you that the New Jersey Department of Health and Senior Services (DHSS) requires vaccines for students entering sixth grade. The **mandatory** regulations state the following:

- Every child born on or after January 1, 1997 and entering grade six on or after September 1, 2008 shall have received one (1) dose of Tdap (Tetanus, diphtheria, acellular pertussis) given no earlier than the 10th birthday.
- Children entering or attending grade six on or after September 1, 2008 who received a Td booster dose less than five (5) years prior to entry or attendance shall not be required to receive a Tdap dose until five (5) years have elapsed from the last DTP/Dtap or Td dose.
- Every child born on or after January 1, 2007 and entering or attending grade six on or after September 1, 2008 shall have received one (1) dose of a meningococcal-containing vaccine, such as the medically-preferred meningococcal conjugate vaccine.

Students must provide documentation to the school of these immunizations **by August 27th 2018**. Therefore, we are requesting that your Primary Care Provider complete the form on the back and/or provide their own documentation and return it to the Ethel Hoppock Middle School by the first day of school in order to be able to attend.
